## 1922 No. 211 (L. 5)

- I, the Right Honourable William, Baron Sterndale, Master of the Rolls, in pursuance and execution of the powers given to me by Section 20 of the Administration of Justice Act, 1920, and all other powers 10 & 11 Geo. and authorities enabling me in that behalf, do make the following 5. c. 81. Regulations:
- 1. The enrolled copy of any Deed, Assurance or other Instrument or Document required or authorised to be enrolled in the Supreme Court or the Central Office thereof, may be typewritten in lieu of being written by hand.
- 2. These Regulations may be cited as the Enrolment of Deeds Regulations, 1922.
- 3. The Regulation made by me under Section 20 aforesaid and dated the 18th day of November, 1921, which came into operation on that day, is superseded and replaced by these Regulations.
